

Wolfgang Thaler Bio-/filmography



Since 1988, Wolfgang Thaler, born in Möllbrücke/Austria, has been working as freelance cinematographer and documentary filmmaker. After his TV reports *In the Land of Bod* (1993) and *Arktis Nordost (Arctic North-East)* (1994) had attracted a lot of attention and earned him praise, Michael Glawogger hired him in 1997 as cinematographer for *Megacities*. In 1998, he for the first time worked together with Ulrich Seidl on the documentary about fun fairs, *Fun without Limits*.

Wolfgang Thaler has cooperated particularly intensively with both directors: For Glawogger he did *Megacities* (1997), *France, here we are*! (1999), *Slugs* (2004), *Workingman's Death* (2006) and *Contact's High* (2009). He stood

behind the camera for Seidl for the following films: *Dog Days* (2001), *Jesus, You Know* (2002) and the prize-winning *Import/Export* (2007).

As director Thaler is, amongst other movies, responsible for the cinema documentary *Ameisen - Die heimliche Weltmacht (Ants – The Secret Global Power)* (2005).

After winning the Austrian "Romy" as best cinematographer in 1999 and the Cinematographers Prize at Diagonale, the Festival of Austrian Film, in 2006 for *Workingman's Death*, Wolfgang Thaler was awarded the Marburger Kamerapreis for his existing oeuvre.
